The Introduction of Motomiya high school and the origin of school emblem

Motomiya High school was founded in July in Syowa Era 24(1949).

It used to be Motomiya Town high school.

On the emblem, the flower and leaf of Japanese spindle tree(Euonymus sieboldianus) is featured.

Mayumi is recite in Manyoshu.

MAYUMI is very strong and flexible wild tree which grows naturally in Mt.Adatara.

MAYUMI is well known as a strong materials for bows.

When ancient people recite the MAYUMI poem, the meaning is "I want to attract and catch your heart" as if I draw strong MAYUMI (a bow and arrow).

Also, MAYUMI is frequently used in school songs those days. It means, 'Grow up as strong as MAYUMI.

The school emblem symbolizes with the wish that children and students will grow up as strong as MAYUMI.
